Mac –

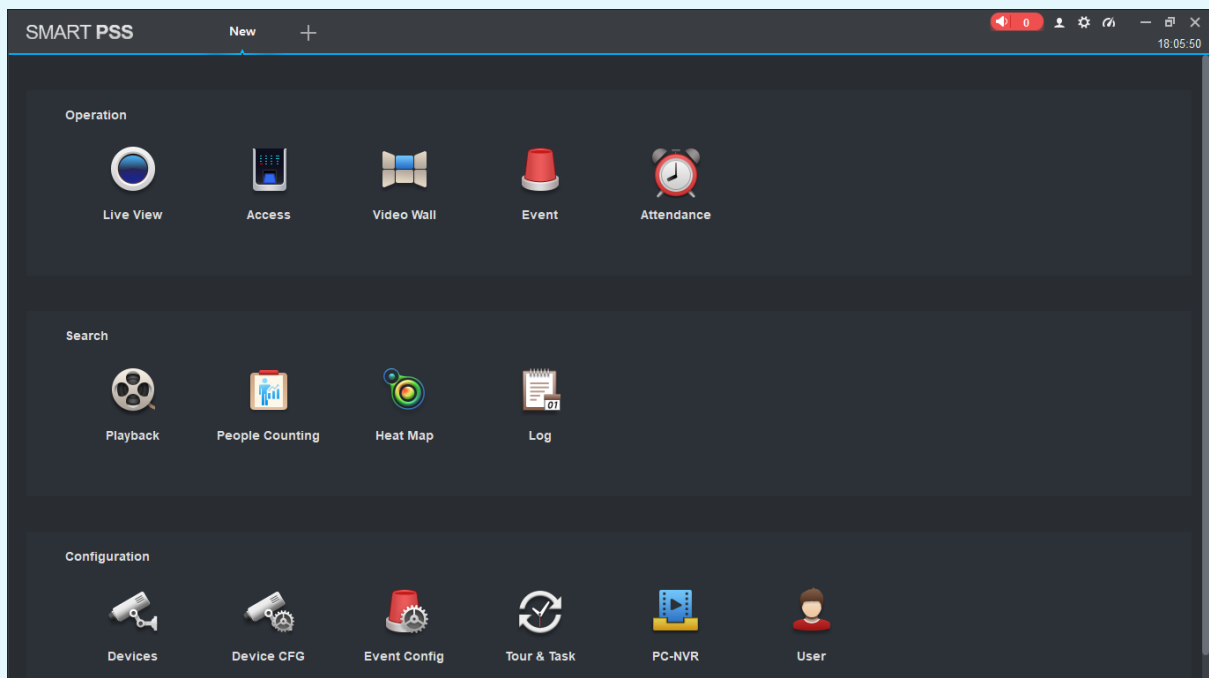
Remotely and Locally – Via Smart PSS

Smart PSS is a downloadable program.

Once downloaded, it will ask you to create a username and password. Just type one in, personal to you and your computer.

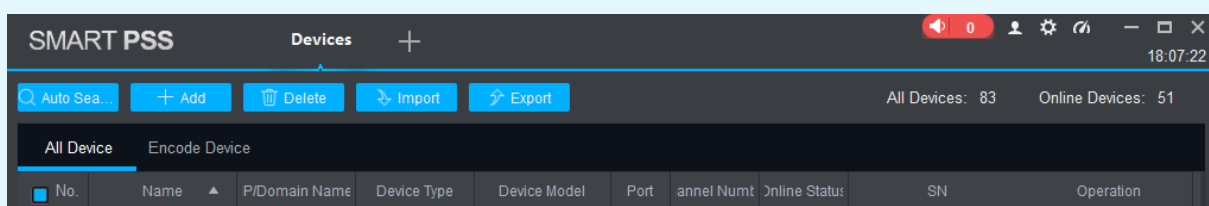
When you open the app, you should see this page:



To add a site/recorder:

Under Configuration – click Devices


You should have this page



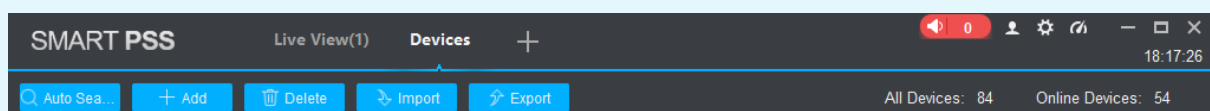
## Remote Viewing & Accessing Dahua NVR

It may take a little while to connect but you will soon see it populate the page with the site, the recorder information and stating whether the unit is offline or online.

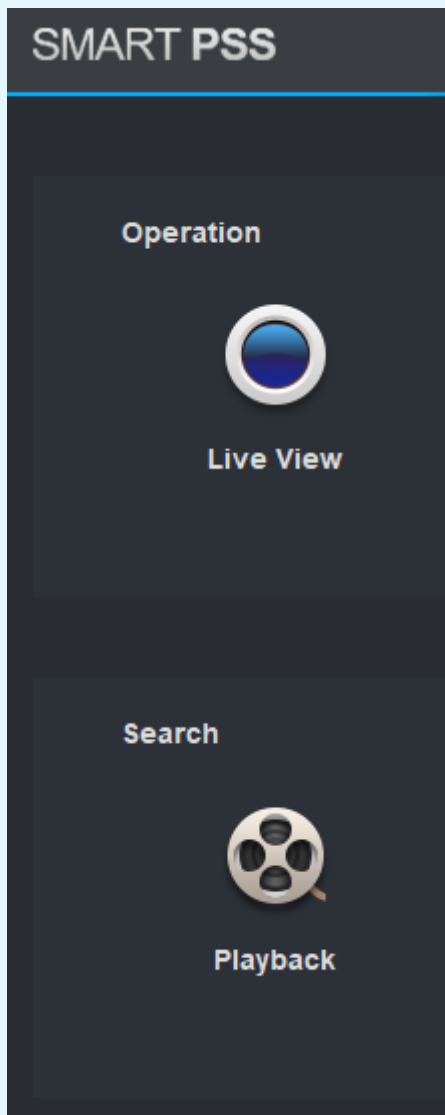
Click the + at the top



It'll take you back to the main page.

Only two areas requiring your attention are Live and Playback

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## Live View

On the left-hand side, you will find your site: e.g., Home/Business

If you double click your site, it will populate the black screen on the right with live view images of the cameras.

- Double click on an image and it will enlarge it, double click again and it will restore to the previous image.
- To best way to stop the live view, e.g., right click on an image and choose "close all videos".

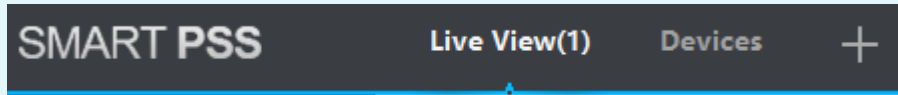
If you have more than 4x cameras, on the bottom right-hand side, you can click different options to load the different number of images.



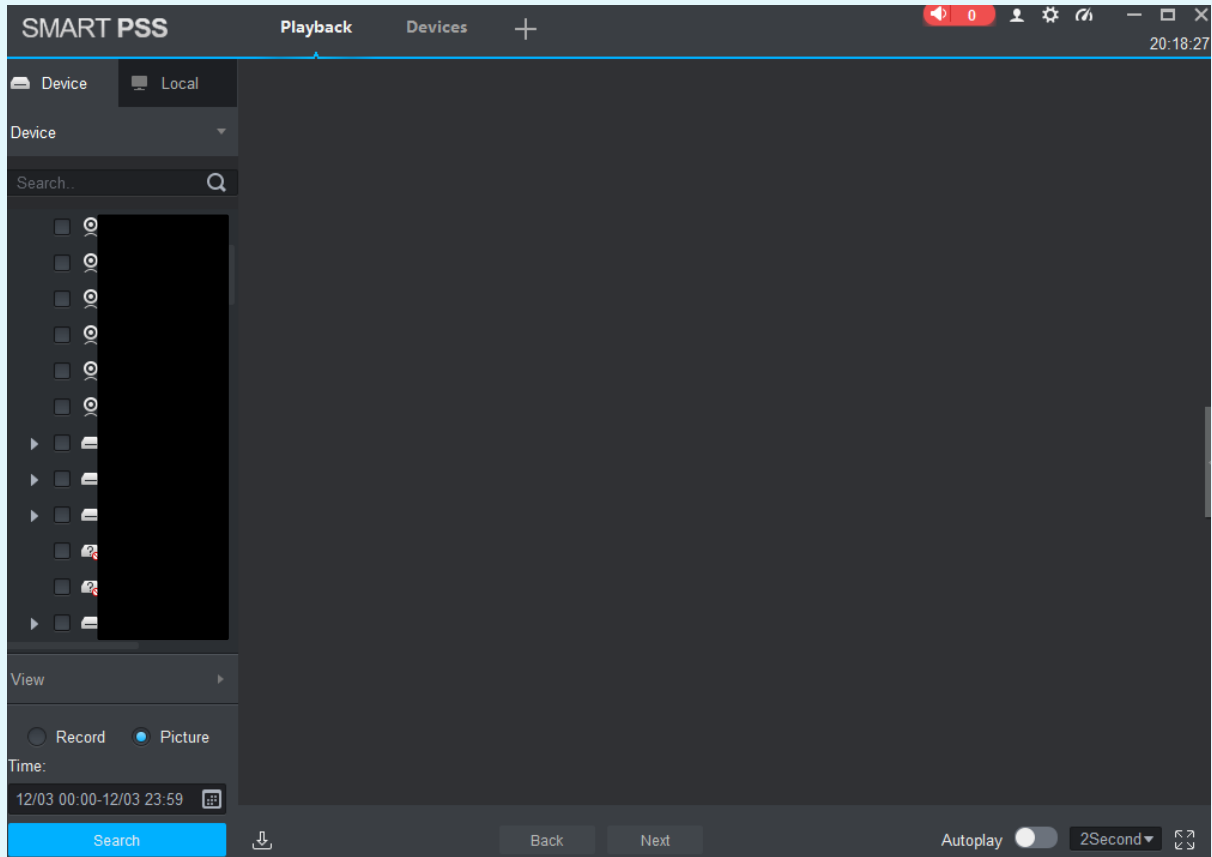
# Remote Viewing & Accessing Dahua NVR

## Playback

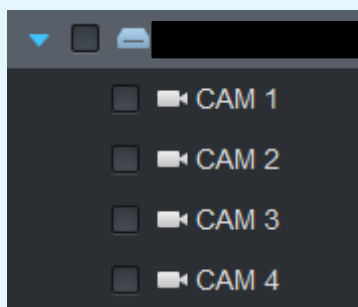
Press the + button again to go back to the menu



Click on Playback



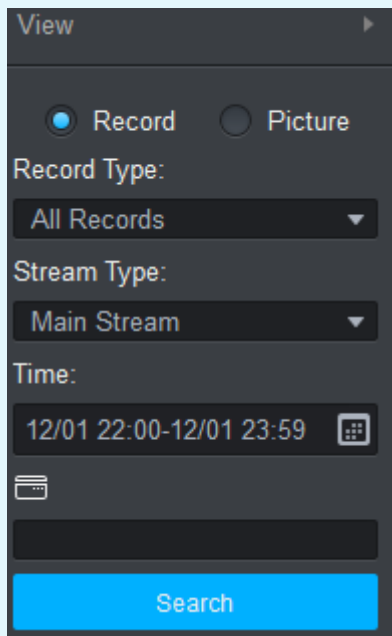
Next to your site name, is an arrow, click on this to present you with the individual camera names



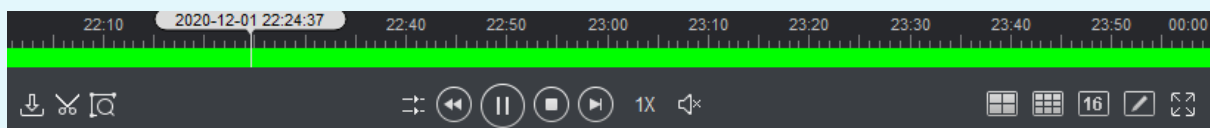
- Click the camera/s you would like to look at footage for.

# Remote Viewing & Accessing Dahua NVR

- Click Record



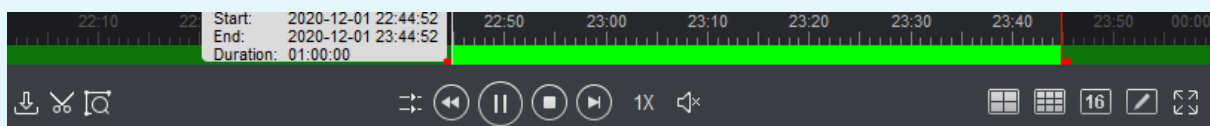
- Choose date and time and then click search
- Click on the timeline to start playback



Buttons are quite self-explanatory. Scroll across the timeline to find the footage of interest.

To download:

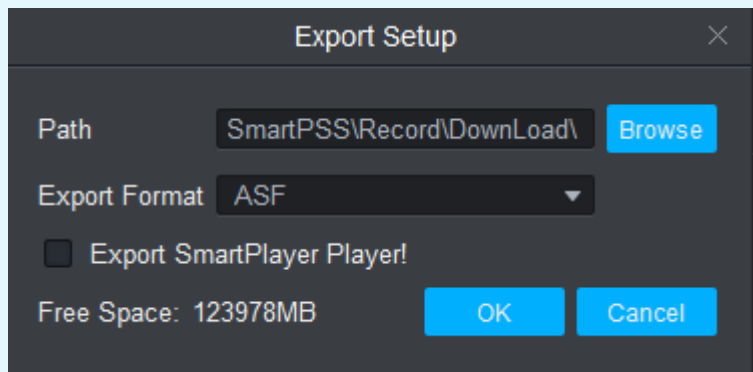
Find the start of the clip of interest, click on the scissor icon



Move the second red flag to where you want the clip to finish, then click on the scissor icon again.

## Remote Viewing & Accessing Dahua NVR



- Choose where you would like to save the file, somewhere you will be able to find it.
- Export Format, we suggest AVI or MP4 as most media players can play these formats.
- Then click ok. The clipped video should download to your specified path.
